Sawyers Hall Students Excel

Sawyers Hall College students have recorded excellent results in this year's GCSE examinations. The College has surpassed all targets set for it by Essex County Council and the overall 5 A*-C pass rate is 75% with 45% of all students attaining %A*-C including English and Maths. All students at the College obtained GCSE qualifications with 95% gaining 5 or more A*-G grades.

Headteacher Stephen Capper said, "We are very impressed with this year's results which show an overall 12% improvement on last year and some really outstanding individual successes at every level. This success is a testament to the hard work of students and staff, supported by parents and governors and everyone should be extremely proud of their achievements."

Chair of Governors, Neil McAree said, "I am delighted with the continued improvement at the College."

Sixth Form Results were also up with the A*-B pass rate increasing from 27% in 2010 to 49% this year – an increase of 22%. Head of Sixth Form, Lauren Roberts said, "The students have worked very hard this year and have competed for some ambitious university places. I am very pleased with the high standard of results."
